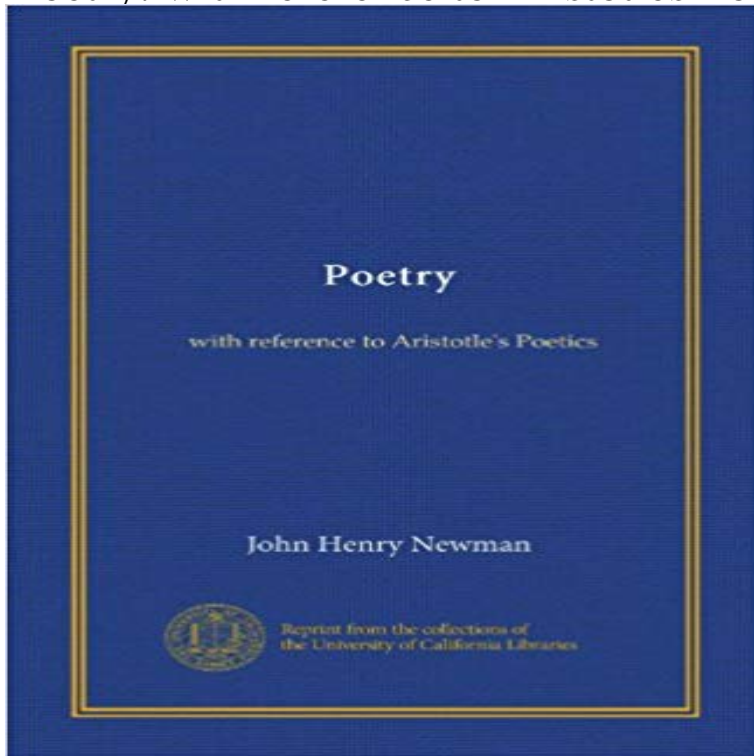


Poetry: with reference to Aristotles Poetics
