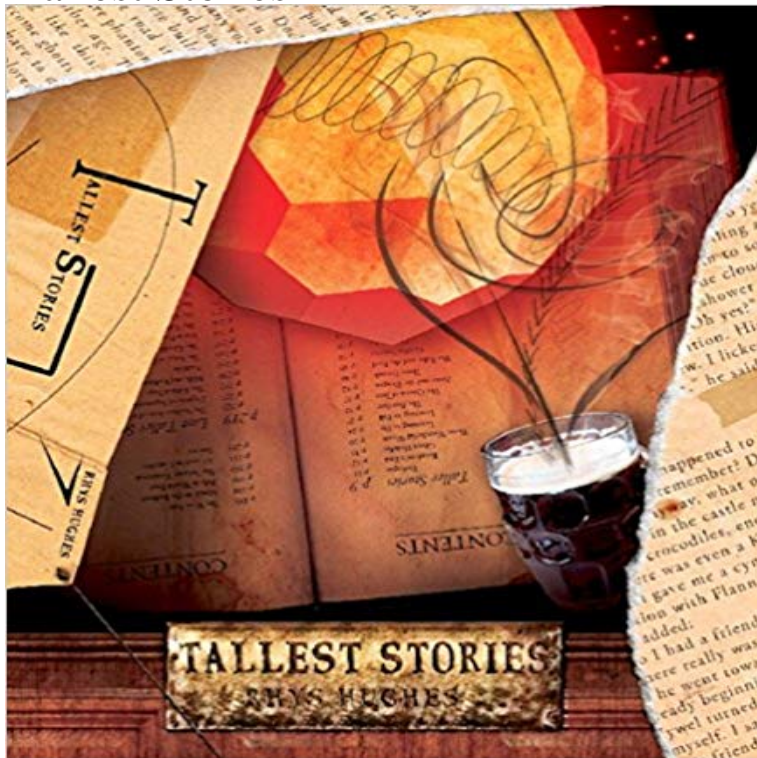


Tallest Stories
